Local Rules

Out of Bounds (Rule 18.2)

- a) Beyond any fence, wall or line of white posts bounding the course
- b) In or beyond the gardens or land of any private residence

Abnormal course conditions (Rule 16.1)

- a) All pathways are deemed immovable obstructions and relief may be obtained under rule 16.1b
- b) Sprinkler heads close to the putting green, relief is obtainable under rule 16.1b. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b. if an immovable obstruction is on the line of play and is within 2 club lengths of the putting green and is within two club lengths of the ball.
Exceptions – no relief if chosen line of play is clearly unreasonable.

Abnormal course conditions – no play zone (Rule 16.1f)

- a) Any area encircled with a white line or marked with a GUR sign. (Rule 16.1a&b)
- b) Protection of young trees identified by stakes, guards or markings. If such a tree interferes with a player's stance or the area of her intended swing, the ball MUST be lifted, without penalty and dropped in accordance with the procedure as prescribed in Rule 16.1b & Rule 14.3b. The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.

Practice Rules 5.2

Practice is permitted on the day of a stroke play competition, or between rounds, on the practice putting green. During play, the practice putting green is a wrong green and relief must be obtained under Rule 13.1f.

Penalty Area (Rule 17)

Penalty areas are identified by yellow stakes or lines, or red stakes or lines. Rule 17.1d applies.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF A LOCAL RULE.

GENERAL PENALTY

Under no circumstances should golf balls be retrieved from the grounds of homes surrounding The Wynyard Club, Wellington Course, or representation made to owners to return the same. Any member or guest contravening this rule may, in the case of the member, have his/her membership terminated, or in the case of a visitor, be barred from the club in future.
